

## Individual Member Galleries

As you know, your Club has a website (<http://www.biphotoclub.org>), and on the website we post photos that members submit to club competitions. Now we're offering you a photo gallery just for a sample of your very own work. The idea: to encourage you to post about a dozen photos of your own on a single topic of your own choice.

The sample gallery that's up on the website now is my own; the topic is Doors. Your topic might be snails, abstracts, fried eggs, fog, Pioneer Square, your choice . You'll find it both challenging and rewarding to assemble and display a topical series of photos — it's something beyond making the usual single images. Achieving unity of the series is easier in monochrome, but a color series should certainly be possible. Take a look at my sample gallery to see how yours will be presented. Mine is at

Here's a set of five lightweight guidelines:

1. A dozen or so photos (+2)
2. Change your gallery every two or three months if you like, not more frequently — with the generous aim of keeping my workload in hand
3. Send me your images by e-mail, and include in the e-mail a title for the gallery (e.g., Doors in my case)
4. The name of each image file should consist of just the title you want on the photo, with .jpg appended (e.g., A Door with Lots to Say.jpg)
5. The format and size should be as for competition images for digital projection; i.e., 760 pixels on the longer side.
