

What if? Artful Explorations of an Inquisitive Photographer

At the February club meeting, Bainbridge photographer Diane Walker will describe and explain some of the processes and presentation methods she's discovered on her journeys in the land of digital photography. Subjects covered will include *Creating Etchings out of Fog*, *National Geographic Collages*, *Fun with the Warp Command*, and *Printing Alternatives: Metal, Silk, Canvas and Fabric*.

Diane Walker has been photographing professionally for 20 years. Her photographs have appeared in a variety of local venues (including the Bainbridge Arts and Crafts Gallery, Bainbridge Bakers, the Bainbridge Athletic Club, Pegasus and the Harbor Pub) and in juried exhibitions at The Center for Fine Art Photography in Colorado, the Minneapolis Photo Center, the Vermont PhotoPlace Gallery, and the Collective Visions Gallery in Bremerton. Her work has also been shown at the Edmonds Art Festival and has won prizes at the Puyallup Fair and the San Juan County Fair. Walker's photos have been published multiple times in *Shutterbug Magazine*, *The Bainbridge Islander* (including numerous covers), *The Kitsap Sun*, and *Exhibition Magazine*, and have also appeared on the covers of several books and on a recent Bainbridge Island phonebook.

Diane's work will be featured at The Children's Boutique in November and at Rooster's Coffee House in December.
