So please, convert your print images to digital according to the same conventions as for competition — that is, name them:

MyName_My Image Title.jpg

and size them to fit in a 760 pixel box, in sRGB color space. They'll make the show much better. You know that.

I do have a few images that were shown as prints, then later sent to me digitally for posting on our website. However, the only copies of those I have are on the website, and they're too small for effective use in the slide show. So if you're one of those people, please resubmit your images in digital form as above.

The Flip Side: Those of you who have been submitting images for projection might start thinking about printing some of them so you can exhibit your prints at the show. There'll be more about that later.

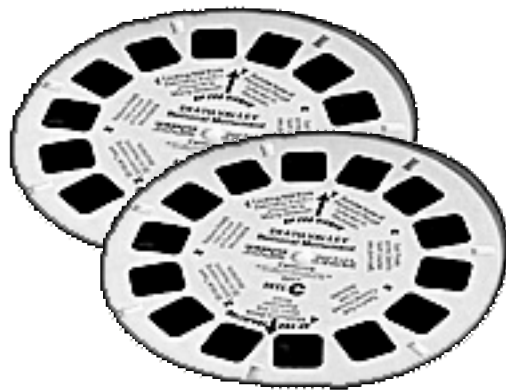

The bad news: Fisher-Price has discontinued the classic scenic and travelogue reels (the Grand Canyon, etc.) for its View-Master 3-D viewer, which has been around since 1939. They still make the viewer and some children's titles, and all of the 1.5 billion reels ever made still work in every model viewer.
