He had never critiqued images such as ours before but after spending the evening critiquing 109 images, he wants to do it again. He will return Sept. 13, his schedule permitting. He gave every image suggestions that he felt would make them stronger, even the 26 pointer. He pointed out the importance of composition, cropping, and color very much like Genevieve, Hal, and Stan do. Questions were asked from the audience, something we would like more of. His comments were helpful to all of us, not just the person who's image he was commenting on. Thank you, Jeff.

In July, Dana Marrs has agreed to be a guest critic. She is an excellent watercolor artist and instructor for both Bainbridge and Poulsbo Parks and Recreation Depts. She is also a regular exhibitor at Bainbridge Arts and Crafts, where she sells her work.
